**Annexure- "A"**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ENGAGEMENT OF PEONS AND SAFAIWALAS ON CONTRACTUAL/OUTSOURCING BASIS IN RAILWAY CLAIMS TRIBUNAL:-**

1. Prior sanction of the Competent Authority, i.e. Hon'ble Chairman/RCT, is to be obtained before initiating a proposal for walk-in-interview to engage Peon/Safaiwalas in the Benches of Railway Claims Tribunal (RCT) on Contractual/Outsourcing basis.
2. Concerned Benches of RCT will publish advertisement in the local newspaper/media calling for walk-in-interview for the posts of Peon/Safaiwalas at a prescribed date and time at location of RCT Benches where vacancies exist and will recommended the names of suitable candidates for approval of Chairman/RCT.
3. The qualification for the Peon should be 10<sup>th</sup> class pass and persons with less than 10<sup>th</sup> class (unskilled) should be engaged as safaiwalas.
4. Remuneration for the outsourced Peon/Safaiwalas will be governed by the minimum wages in force in the state in which engagement is to be undertaken.
5. The Railway working hours will be 8 hours per day from 09:30 hrs to 18:00 hrs with half an hour lunch break from 13:30 hrs to 14:00 hrs on all working days.
6. Since RCT is a judicial organization, it has to be made clear to candidate that any leak of confidential information may lead to legal action including prosecution.
7. If the person engage/hired, remains absent, pro-data deduction will be made from the amount payable to him/her. The amount of deduction will be worked out on the basis of 1/30<sup>th</sup> of the lump sum amount per day of absence.
8. Giving one month's prior notice by either party can terminate this contractual engagement.
9. The above contractual arrangement would be for a period not exceeding one year from the date of acceptance of the terms and conditions for such engagement or till the posts are filled by Zonal Railways, whichever is earlier. Suitable break should invariably be given between two successive contracts (if any).
10. Engagement of persons under this scheme does not constitute any offer of appointment in Railway Claims Tribunal or Railways.
11. Recovery has to be made from the monthly wages for any willful damage/loss to equipment or property that may be caused by the persons engaged.
12. The age of the candidates for engagement of Group-D staff on contract/outsourcing basis should be minimum of 18 years and maximum 45 years.
13. The candidates may be engaged only after they are certified as medically fit for which a Medical Fitness Certificate issued by a General Physician having a minimum MBBS Degree is mandatory.
