- 1. A meeting was organised on 20.04.21 with the advocates practicing at RCT, Delhi which included the office bearers of the three Bar Associations namely Bar Association of RCT/Delhi, Bar Association of erstwhile RCT/Ghaziabad and the Association of Railway Advocates. The main agenda of the meeting was to take a considered decision in view of lockdown declared in Delhi area and the recent order of Hon. High Court of Delhi to allow hearings in urgent matters only and adjourning other matter en bloc.
- 2 The meeting commenced with the Registrar, RCT, Smt. Aashima Mehrotra, extending a warm welcome to all the participants. She briefed the

participants about the agenda of the meeting and Bar Association representatives were requested to express their view on the matter.

- 3. Advocates namely, Shri Dushyant Swaroop, Shri M.S. Bhatia, Smt Ashima Sood, Smt Anju Bagai, Shri Nitesh Sharma, Shri Saurabh Gupta and Shri B.S Mahur stated that since Covid-19 situation has reached to an alarming stage, it would be better if virtual court hearings are suspended for the time being atleast up to 30th April, 2021. Citing recent orders of Hon. High Court of Delhi. Railway advocates expressed difficulty in movement of court files and receipt/submision of WS and DRM's report on account of the prevailing lockdown situation in Delhi and Railway staff and advocates being found Corona positive in numbers. Shri Mahur stated that final arguments and execution matters can be taken up through virtual mode, if deemed proper.
- 4.However, other advocates namely, Shri N.K. Gupta, Shri Subhash Sachdeva and Shri H.K. Gautam expressed their views that virtual Court hearings should continue as is being held at present stating that WS etc., can be filed digitally in PDF form and that the cause of the litigant should not suffer. They also raised the issue of pendency of execution applications and their timely/immediate listings before Benches.
- 5. Shri C.P Singh, advocate from Lucknow informed that at RCT, Lucknow court proceedings have already been suspended till 30th April, 2021.
- 6. After listening to views of advocates on the issue from both sides and discussing the matter with Shri Sunil Mathur, Hon. Member (Tech) and MrsAashima Mehrotra, Registrar, Hon'ble Chairman issued the following directions:
 - a) From 23.04.2021 till 30.04.2021, two regular Benches shall function at RCT, Delhi virtually through video conferencing.
 - b) Till 23rd April, cause list will remain as it is, however from 26th April onwards 3 cases of Final Arguments and 11 cases of Misc Applications involving decision on condonation of delay, execution applications, corrections in judgment/orders, release of FDRs etc shall be listed before each Bench.

- c) Court Masters concerned shall give dates in remaining all cases of WS, framing of issues, applicant's evidence, respondent's evidence and further proceedings cases. No case shall be left without being given a further date.
- d) Registry shall make all efforts to put in place a system so that any execution application and miscellaneous applications of all nature filed by an advocate is listed before the concerned Bench within 48 hours of its filing.
- e) No adverse orders shall be passed for non-appearance of litigant/advocate concerned.

The proceedings of the meeting concluded with the Vote of thanks to the Chair and all theattendees.
